

SHOWCASE OF TALENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Total number of acts showcased:
 - Friday evening, (7 acts)
 - Saturday afternoon (8 acts)
 - TOTAL: 15 acts
2. To be eligible to showcase:
 - Agency/act must be a paid member* of the Kansas Fairs Association for at least the past 23 months before being eligible to showcase. This 23 month period will start with the first convention after joining the Kansas Fairs Association.
 - Agency/act must have a display room or booth at the Kansas Fairs Association Convention. Booths on the main floor will be assigned to an agency/act that has a room on one of the floors above the first floor and not adjacent to the Atrium. Agency/acts occupying these types of booths cannot showcase from the booth. No amplification equipment will be allowed from the booths. This type of activity must be either from the showcase or from a room assigned. An act or agency will not be permitted to work outside of a booth or assigned room.
 - An agent must represent an act that showcases during the Saturday afternoon session. An agent is defined as a person or agency that represents at least three (3) different acts or entertainers that play at least six different venues each year.
3. Eligible agencies must submit a showcase request form prior to November 1. The name of the act must be submitted to the Kansas Fairs Association by DECEMBER 1. 4. Showcase dates (preference) will be assigned according to order request forms are received. (This will be by post office post-marked date).
5. The showcase producer will assign the order of performance.
6. Each showcase shall be a live performance. NO taped or lip sync music will be allowed without authorization by showcase producer.
7. Each act will be allowed 20 MINUTES to perform (WHICH INCLUDES YOUR INTRODUCTIONS). If the act goes over the time limit, they will be subject to losing eligibility for the next convention.
8. If more applicants are received then showcase positions, any act that has performed in the previous year will not be assigned a time to showcase. If this procedure fails to reduce the amount of acts available participation will be determined by lottery draw. **

* Membership does not guarantee a showcase spot.

** The Kansas Fairs and Festivals Association reserves the discretionary right to amend and interpret the above stated rules and regulations.

THESE RULES AS WELL AS AN INVITATION WILL BE MAILED IN OCTOBER TO ALL AGENTS, ENTERTAINERS AND ACTS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE TO SHOWCASE AT THE NEXT YEARLY CONVENTION.
